Parish of St. Bernard, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), on Saturday, May 3, 2025, to submit to the electors of the Parish the following proposition:

PROPOSITION (SALES TAX) Shall the Parish of St. Bernard, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), be authorized to levy and collect in accordance with Louisiana law a sales and use tax of 0.10% (the "Tax") (an estimated \$1,166,667 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the Tax for an entire year), for a period of 4 years, beginning July 1, 2025, with the proceeds of the Tax, after paying reasonable and necessary costs and expenses of collecting and administering the Tax, to be used for the purpose of paying costs associated with litigation opposing the proposed Louisiana International Terminal project, including but not limited to expert costs and attorney's fees, as well as participation		
in the United States Army Corps of Engineers permitting process for said project; provided, the Tax is subject to early termination upon passage of an ordinance determining that all current and/or anticipated litigation opposing the project is complete, whereupon collected but unspent sales tax funds shall be used for infrastructure improvements in the Parish?
